The Future



- RHCs emerge as the core rural healthcare provider and self-modernize
 - Voluntarily collect and report quality data
- PB-RHCs take a leadership role in CAH performance improvement programs
- Expand clinical services with creative arrangements with specialty providers and health systems
- Define and advance new RHC-centered alternative payment models
- Demonstrate leadership around education and prevention to prepare for future epidemics
- Make RHCs a preferred venue for providers to practice medicine
- Use the PCMH model as an indispensable strategic asset:
 - Establish and maintain operational excellence
 - Define industry “outstanding performance” via PCMH standards
 - Defend against staff shortages by developing durable systems of care
 - Eliminate waste and increase satisfaction through improved operations

- Building on this foundation, we are working across CMS to enhance the movement towards value-based, high-quality care and to ensure that we are all rowing in the same direction so that 100 percent of people with original Medicare will be in a care relationship with accountability for quality and total cost of care by 2030.
